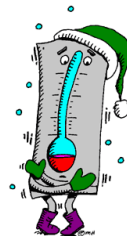
Parents,

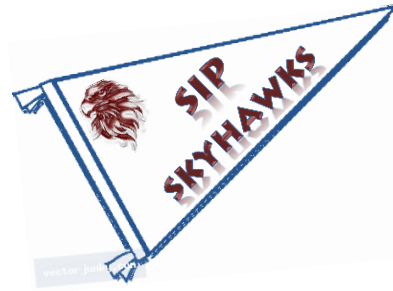
