Please make sure that while you are waiting in the carline to pick up your child, that you are not blocking the driveways of our neighbors.

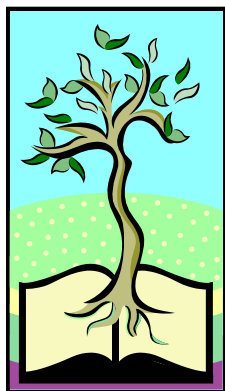
