Middle School & High School Skyhawk Pin Awards are here!

Skyhawk Pins will be given only at the end of each semester for middle and high school. The following criteria must be met to earn the Skyhawk Pins:

Middle School:

Gold Pin: 95 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, participation in three community service projects.

Silver Pin: 90 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, participation in two community service projects.

Bronze Pin: 85 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, Participation in one community service project.

- *Middle school students should request a community service log sheet from their advisor upon participation in a community service project. It is the student's responsibility to request the log sheet, **fill it out completely**, and return it to their advisory teacher. This is how the S.I.P. Middle Campus will document community service hours for awards purposes.*

High School:

Gold Pin: 95 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, 15 hours of community service earned that semester.

Silver Pin: 90 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, 12.5 hours of community service earned that semester.

Bronze Pin: 85 or higher in each class, no detentions, no unexcused absences or tardies, 10 hours of community service earned during semester.

- High School community service hours will continue to be logged by Mrs. Rosenbaum for awards and graduation purposes.
