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### **New Schedules!**

- On Thursday, September 24, all parents received new scholar schedules and progress reports via email. These schedules will go into effect on Monday, September 28th.
- For most scholars, class periods have changed, but teachers have not.

### **6th Grade Return To School \*Must Read\***

- On Monday, September 28, 6th grade in-person and hybrid scholars in Group A report to campus!

- **Before School/Arrival:**
  - Send your scholars to school with a fully charged chromebook or personal device, charger, and headphones, please!
  - Gates will open for secondary carline at 7:45am. Please prepare for a longer length of time for carline during these first few days.
  - Complete the Luminare survey for your household at home before leaving for carline to make sure you are cleared to come to campus. Completing the Luminare survey ahead of time will also help speed up carline.

  - Remember, if any scholar in a car fails the symptom check or temperature check, then none of the scholars in the car may come to school that day.
- **During School:**
  - Scholars will be podded and teachers will rotate to them in an isolated classroom.
  - Lunch will be provided for all scholars and will be taken in the classroom. Scholars will not have access to a microwave.
  - In order to limit the spread of COVID, scholars will only be able to occupy restrooms one at a time.
- **Dismissal**
  - Begins at 3:45pm. Make sure you have your carline number in order to release your scholar for dismissal.
  - At 4:15pm, any scholars who walk home and any scholars who have not been picked up yet will be walked out of the gates to Bryan Street to be dismissed. Please make every effort to pick up your scholar before 4:15 in order to prevent them from being in close contact with other scholars when released on Bryan Street.
