## REMOTE LEARNING QUICK GUIDE & INSTRUCTIONS



Single Sign-On technology allowing teachers and students access to everything they need with just one login!

Dear Uplift Parents and Scholars-

Uplift has been working very hard to design experiences for the new school year that will challenge and engage your child during this time. Starting Monday, we kick off a new phase of at-home learning for our scholars.

Uplift will now be using Schoology through ClassLink, a single sign-on platform that will allow teachers and students to use one username and password to access everything they need. This will enable our scholars, parents and teachers to engage with learning materials and their school community from the classroom and beyond. A single sign-on is an essential tool for productive remote learning for our scholars, whether it is in the classroom or in the comfort of their home. Schoology is accessible through ClassLink from either your personal home computer, an Uplift issued Chromebook or any smartphone.

We look forward to using Schoology in our classrooms to enhance connectivity and communication across our network. With Schoology, scholars can digitally submit homework assignments, review grades, participate in interactive discussions, receive announcements and feedback, take tests, and more. As a parent, you will be able to view your child's activity within the platform.

Here is how to help get your child started on a **computer**:

2. Enter your unique username and password
3. Follow the attached [tutorial](#) ([Spanish](#)) (A message will prompt you to install an extension when accessing applications).



Here is how to help get your child started on a **mobile device**:

1. Download the appropriate ClassLink app:

**\*Be sure not to use the mobile device's browser and only these mobile app options.**
2. Click the arrow in the top right corner to search for and choose "Your School" (one-time selection).
3. Enter your unique username and password
4. Follow the attached [tutorial](#).

**Please note: Scholars will need to log in to Schoology every day starting on August 10<sup>th</sup> to be counted for attendance. If a scholar does not have access to a computer or smartphone, attendance can be confirmed the week of August 10<sup>th</sup> by contacting your scholar's teacher.**
