HIGHLIGHTS

Primary School Highlights

- ♦ 91% of our kinder scholars met their math goals and 80% met reading
- ♦ 86% of scholars passed the STAAR test in the first administration, which was 3rd in the network; after the second administration 92% passed.
- Our SpEd scholars did well comparatively on STAAR this year with higher STAAR score averages than both the state and the district.

Middle School Highlights


- One hundred percent of eighth grade Algebra I students exceeded the state standard on the Algebra I EOC
- ♦ In the Spring semester, middle school scholars completed more than 1,400 hours of documented community service benefitting organizations such as The Stewpot, The Wilkenson Center, The Soup Mobile and The Tide Foundation.
- ♦ Scholars in all grades exceeded the National Norm in all MAP subjects in all grade levels.

High School Highlights


