Parents must use the state-assigned unique access code to log into the portal (<https://www.texasassessment.com/>) to view their child's STAAR scores and access additional resources. If you do not know your child's state-assigned unique access code, then there is a look-up feature that asks for a child's first name, PEIMS ID (SSN), and date of birth.
