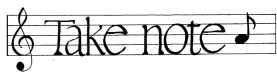
A Message from Administration

Rosters will be available during Meet the Teacher Night and on the first day of school. Kinder scholars are assigned to a homeroom for the first 2 weeks of school so that teachers may get to know them and determine what works best. All our K teachers are experienced teachers and will offer an amazing educational experience for your child. Parents will be notified of permanent classroom placement for kindergarteners on August 12th.

Educational Resource of the Week

Note to 3rd-5th Grade Parents All STAAR scores are now available in the "STATE" student portal. Parents must use the state-assigned unique access code to log into the portal (<https://www.texasassessment.com/>) to view their child's STAAR scores and access additional resources. If you do not know your child's state-assigned unique access code, then there is a look-up feature that asks for a child's first name, PEIMS ID (SSN), and date of birth.
